- Build on #nofilter #lifewithnofilter 2021 awareness campaign to drive testing and detection of CKD.

- Create an evidence-based support program for people with kidney disease for all stages of their journey.
- Leverage our credibility in providing evidenced-based information for health professionals so Kidney Health Australia remains a trusted partner in support of people with kidney disease.

- Foster emergence of a powerful kidney crowd and advocate strongly for improved outcomes to government and relevant parties.
- Ensure Kidney Health Australia is recognised as a reputable charity.
- Be a valued presence in the health policy community.

- Partner with ANZSN to develop a Kidney Research Alliance that facilitates impactful research outcomes and research investment.
- Foster development of key research priorities with patients and researchers to improve outcomes for people with kidney disease.

- Advocate strongly to government for financial support.
